Note: The Australian Rules Academy has been introduced to Year 7 students in 2020. This will expand in future years.

How does the Football (Australian Rules and Soccer) Academy fit into the school program?

- Australian Rules/Soccer-purposed sessions are held during normal timetabled Physical Education classes.
- Physical Education theory lessons are themed with Australian Rules/Soccer content where possible.
- Specialist training sessions outside of school timetable to cater for senior students.
- Excursions are held which further complement the curriculum, such as Melbourne Victory training sessions, AAMI Park tours, A-League games, coaching clinics, special guest appearances by professional players and coaches. A similar program has commenced in 2021 for the Australian Rules Academy.

Students are expected to maintain a consistent satisfactory academic performance and behaviour to stay in the program.

- Students have greater exposure to being chosen for Interschool Australian Rules/Soccer teams and compete in competitions such as: Australian Futsal Championships (Gold Coast), SSV Futsal, SSV 11-a-side and AFL competitions.
- VCE/VCAL students can continue with a Soccer focused study through VET Certificate III Sport & Recreation. Practical sessions are delivered in line with the FFA National Curriculum (SAP and GTP). The Australian Rules stream has not been developed in VCE/VCAL yet.

FFA Coaching, Refereeing (Level 1) and First Aid Certificates are delivered within the later years program.
